EBSF is following RI [Summer-Camp Guidance](#)

EBSF operates 100% outdoors. If bad weather is forecasted we will cancel the class by sending out an email the night before.

- I. Class Size and Stable groups:**
 - A. Class sizes will be max 26 children per group and will remain stable and distanced from other groups per RI and CDC summer camp guidelines.
- II. Physical Distancing**
 - A. Physical distancing of 3 feet is recommended when possible, but not required within each stable group.
 - B. Groups will maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance between stable groups and have designated zones to for each group to make it easy
 - C. Groups will have designated time using shared spaces to get on and off the water
 - D. EBSF will forbid mixing between groups
- III. Face Masks**
 - A. All staff and campers must have masks on their person at all times. Staff and campers must wear masks when 3 ft of separation cannot be maintained or when inside. Good news is that our camp operates 100% outside!
- IV. Screening Procedures**
 - A. Staff and visitors will complete the [self-attestation form](#) each day before coming to camp.
 - B. Parents must screen children for symptoms of COVID-19 at home each day before camp using the [self-attestation form](#).
 - C. All children and staff must stay home if they fail the screening prior to leaving for camp.
- V. Handwashing guidelines for staff & children**
 - A. Staff and Students must wash their hands for at least 20 seconds frequently throughout the day but especially at the beginning and end of the session, prior to any snack times, after cleaning, an after using the restroom
 - B. Staff must also wash hands after assisting a student and or handling the same equipment as a student.
 - C. EBSF will provide hand washing stations and hand sanitizer. Program director is responsible for maintaining supply.
 - D. Signage regarding hand washing will be posted in all restrooms.
- VI. Cleaning and decontamination**
 - A. EBSF will clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces within the camp facility.
 - B. There will be specific bathroom times for each group. Bathrooms will be cleaned and disinfected before and after groups by staff
- VII.** EBSF Staff will also clean and disinfect all shared equipment, including life jackets, prior to the start of each new class daily.
- VIII. Ventilation**
 - A. EBSF operates 100% outside
